1. When did UHV start in your institute?

Twenty of our faculty members attended an eight-day Teachers' Orientation Program on 'Human Values and Professional Ethics' at PSIT College of Engineering, Kanpur between 26th May and 2nd June 2014. Following this, we commenced with the UHV program in all our institutes

2. Why did you start the UHV program at your Institute?

The objectives of the Universal Human Values program were:

- a. To help the students appreciate the essential complementarity between 'VALUE' and 'SKILLS' to ensure happiness and prosperity which are the core aspirations of all human beings.
- b. To facilitate the development of a holistic perspective among students towards life, profession and happiness, based on the correct understanding of human reality and the rest of Existence. Such a holistic perspective forms the basis of value-based living in a natural way.
- c. To highlights the plausible implications of such a holistic understanding in terms of ethical human conduct, trustful and mutually satisfying human behaviour and mutually enriching interaction with nature.

Thus, this course intended to provide a much needed orientation input in value education to the young, enquiring minds. We realized the importance of these objectives and decided to start the UHV program at our Institute.

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7. Atmiya Group of Institutions has started Value Education as a subject in the MN Virani Science College. Around 1200 students (B.Sc. and M.Sc.) are taking this subject every year. As a part of this course, students engage in different activities, assignments as well as socially relevant projects. As a consequence of taking this course, it is observed that many students have now begun thinking about the environment, what they can do to safeguard the same and what they should do for the society they live in. For the really keen students, we conduct an additional session of 3 hours every Sunday.
8. The Atmiya Group of Institutions has also started *Chetana Vikas Mulya Siksha* as a subject in Classes 1 to 8. In Classes 1 to 5 students go through the books of Abhibhavak Vidhyalaya. This content has also been translated into Gujarati Language to make it more accessible for students. In classes 6 to 8 students are encouraged to engage in assignment-based activities.

9. We also conducted a session for the parents of school childrens. So impressed were the parents in this one-day session that they came up with a request to attend the full 8 days workshop. This workshop is yet to be planned, but we intend doing it as soon as possible.
10. The Yogi Divine Society also arranged a special session with the trustees, principals and policy makers. This session was conducted by Shri Pradipkumar from IIIT Hyderabad at Atmiya Vidhya Dham on 6th March, 2016. After the successful completion of this session most of the college staff is now eager to attend the full 8-days workshop.
11. We have also translated some of the content of UHVE book into Gujarati. This was done with the objective of spreading the message among the masses, all of whom may not be comfortable or fluent in English and/or Hindi.
