UNIVERSAL HUMAN VALUES (UHV)



EXISTENCE IS CO-EXISTENCE

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Existence is all that exists. In existence, there are units submerged in space. This is called co-existence. Units are limited in size and space is all-pervading. Every unit is an activity being active with other units, and space is No-activity. Being in space, units are energized, and self-organized, recognizing and fulfilling their relationship with every other unit. To put it in one word, units are 'submerged' in space. Units are of two kinds: material and consciousness. The material units have only the activity of recognizing and fulfilling, while consciousness units have the activity of knowing, assuming, recognizing, and fulfilling. Thus, there are three kinds of reality in existence: material, consciousness, and space. As material units are bounded in time and space, they are called temporary. The consciousness units are unbounded in time but limited in space, and are called continuous. Space is unbounded in time and space, and hence called ever.

Co-existence is ever present, for all time and all places. Co-existence is ever effective which means that the principle of Co-existence applies to every reality, from the smallest atom to the biggest, i.e. Nature as a whole. It is ever-expressing. It is expressed in the form of four orders of nature: physical order, bio-order, animal order, and human order, with their definite innateness, natural characteristics, and inheritance. The physical order includes units right from atoms to celestial bodies. The bio-order includes units from cells to the human body. The animal order which includes birds and animals, is awakened to activities of selecting/tasting. The human order is awakened to activities of selecting/tasting, analyzing/comparing, and imaging, and has the potential to know i.e. can awaken to the activities of contemplation, understanding, and realization. The submergence of nature in space is reflected as "interaction" in physical order and "interaction with pulsation" in the bio-order. In animal order, it reflects as "sensitivity" in the Self while in the human order, it reflects as "knowability" in the Self. In the animal body or human body, it reflects as "interaction & pulsation" just like bio-order.

In the whole of nature, it is only the Self that has the potential to know, providing scope for development. One may note that the Self of a human being has to potential to ensure the Contemplation of Relationship, Understanding of Harmony, and Realization of Co-existence which leads to a state of continuous happiness. As a human being, on one hand, one needs to work for the realization of co-existence, and on the other, participate in the larger order leading to universal human order and human tradition. Existence is Co-existence and the role of a human being is to realize this co-existence and live in co-existence.
